

"God's Indescribable Gift"
II Corinthians 9:15

The Gift of Christmas Is the Gift of God Himself to Us - Jo 3:16; I Pet 1:6

- He comes in Person to offer us His Life through His Son - Lk 2:10-11; Heb 10:14
- ...The Gift proclaims, "I am your needs met!" - Jo 10:10; II Pet 1:3,4

It Calls for a Simple Response: Receive the Gift - Jo 1:12; Ro 5:17

- The Gift is freely offered to all ("whosoever") - Jo 3:16; 4:14; Ro 10:11-13; I Jo 4:15; 5:1; I Tim 2:24; II Pet 3:9
- ...You may do a "gift exchange" - Is 61:3

It Is Lived Out By a Simple Prayer: The Prayer of Union - Lk 1:38

- "Whatever You say, I say 'Yes!'" - Matt 9:28; Jo 11:27; II Cor 1:20
- ...Every time we say "Yes" to The Gift, the Word of the Lord is "born" into our lives - Matt 1:24; Lk 1:38
- This is what makes us overcomers - Jo 16:33; I Jo 5:4,5

It Compels Us to a Simple Ministry: Glorify The Giver - I Cor 10:31; Col 3:17

- Whatever we freely receive from God, we freely give away - Matt 10:7-8; Acts 20:35
- ...That which is true of God must become true in the people of God - Mk 10:45; Lk 22:27
- When we "will" the "good" of others (Lk 2:40), we worship the Giver - Ro 12:1-2; Ja 1:17
- ...Give them a "fruit basket" - Ga 5:22-23
- Liturgy: a public service or order of worship
- ...True Liturgy: Receive your gift(s) from God then give them away to His glory - II Cor 9:7-14
- All God's children are extremely wealthy - II Cor 4:7; Col 2:3; Ro 11:33; Eph 3:8; II Pet 1:3,4
- ...All to be liberally and freely given away - II Cor 9:11-13
