

**The Christ-Expressed Life:

The Natural Consequence of a Christ-enlivened, Christ-esteemed, Christ-edited Life Is Christ Increasingly Expressing His Character in and through Us - Col 1:27; 3:4

(What is impossible for us is possible for Him - Matt 19:26; Lk 1:37)

At Our Salvation, God Miraculously Made Us New Creatures - II Cor 5:17; Col 1:12; 3:9,10

- He did so through an immersion ("baptism") into Christ's death and resurrection - Ro 6:1-11

...no one needs more than this Christ gives - Jo 1:16; Col 2:9,10; 3:4

The Miracle of Salvation - Ga 2:20

- "I have been crucified with Christ" - Ro 6:3,6,11

...the miracle of Christian life begins with death - Col 1:21,22; 3:3

- "It is no longer I who live" - Col 3:3

..."but Christ lives in me" - Col 1:27

- "The life I now live in the flesh" - Ro 6:4,11

...new in kind, type, species - II Cor 5:17

- "I live by faith in the Son of God" - Col 2:6

...plus nothing! - Col 2:10

...the only way for the finite to experience the Infinite is by faith - Heb 11:6

- "Who loved me and gave Himself up for me" - Ro 5:8-10

...nothing Christian is ever self-generated - Jo 15:5; Col 2:6

Mary's Example - Lk 1:26-38

- We see how important it is to be honest - Lk 1:29,34

- We recognize the necessity of humility - Lk 1:38; Ja 4:6; I Pet 5:6-7

- We must be willing to be the "home" of the Miracle Worker - Matt 19:26; Matt 13:58
