(John 1:14-16)

We Do Not Seek Life/Freedom in Truth or in Grace, But in Jesus Christ - Jo 1:12

- The fullness of both grace and truth are in Him - Jo 1:14
- Jesus Christ is God's full and final Word on both grace and truth

Under Grace, God Is the Actor

- All God's activity is in the Person of Jesus Christ
- Jesus Christ is the Promised One of God, committed to rescuing us
- We are to abide in His promises, trust in His commitments
- Jesus Christ is both Promiser and Performer - Ro 4:19-21

Grace Says That Salvation Is Initiated, Accomplished and Supplied by God

- "I WILL COME FOR YOU." - Jo 1:14; 3:16
  - ...to demonstrate God's love - Ro 5:8
  - ...to reveal the nature of God - Jo 1:18
  - ...to make a righteous way into God's family - Jo 1:12
- "I WILL DELIVER YOU." - Ro 8:2-4
  - ...good works could not give us a passing grade - but God did
    - Ro 8:4
  - ...trying hard could not put us right with God - but God did
    - Ro 3:21-24
  - ...human strength could not overcome our enemies - but God did
    - Zeph 3:15
  - ...self-effort could not join us to God - but God did
    - Ro 5:10
- "I WILL SUPPLY YOU." - Phil 4:19
  - ...with every directive comes a corresponding supply of His Life
  - ...He will finish what He began
    - Phil 1:6
  - ...each situation requires a fresh supply of His Life
    - Jo 1:16; Lam 3:22-23
