Mystery: That Which Is <u>Concealed</u> from Ordinary View – Prov 25:2; Ro 16:25; I Cor 2:7; Eph 1:18; 3:9

- The Truth of any mystery must first be <u>revealed</u> by God Eph 1:18; 3:3,5; Ga 1:11-12 ...known only by <u>faith</u> Eph 3:17
- The true knowledge of a mystery will not make us <u>proud</u>, but keep us <u>humble</u> Eph 3:7-8

Paul Proclaims the Mystery of Our Union with God and with One Another - Eph 3:6; Col 1:26-27

- Resulting in the infinite riches of Christ Eph 3:8; 1 Cor 3:21-23
 - ...immense in scope, in reach, and in power Eph 3:7-9
- We Are:
 - ...<u>fellow/joint heirs</u> Eph 3:16; 1 Cor 3:21-23; Titus 3:7
 - children of God with <u>adult standing</u> and <u>immediate access</u> to family resources
 Ro 8:14-17
 - = In Christ, we each and all have <u>full and equal</u> access to the wealth of our Father
 - ...fellow/joint body members Eph 3:6; 1 Cor 12:12-27
 - = none of us has <u>preferred status</u> 1 Cor 12:14-18
 - = In Christ, we each and all have <u>full and equal</u> value/worth in the church
 - ...fellow/joint partakers Eph 3:6; Eph 1:3; Il Pet 1:3,4
 - = full inclusion in the eternal life of God's Spirit Eph 1:13; Il Tim 1:1; I Jo 2:27
 - = In Christ, we each and all are <u>full and equal</u> participants in the Life of Christ
- This is the eternal purpose of God in Christ Eph 3:11
