

Consider Jesus: The Gift Everyone's Looking For
 Hebrews 7:25-28

The Gift of Christmas Is the Gift of God Himself – Heb 7:27; II Cor 9:15

- Jesus came on purpose with a purpose...
 - ...to save/deliver – Lk 2:10-11
- God's gifts often come in packages we don't easily recognize – Is 9:1-7
 - ...a child is born: speaks of His humanity
 - ...a son is given: speaks of His Divinity
- His gifts are always freely offered – Heb 7:27; Mk 10:45

We Must Receive and Celebrate His Gifts – Jo 3:16; I:12

- God's gifts can never be purchased with human currency – Eph 2:8-9
 - ...to rightly celebrate Christmas we must first be receivers – Ro 4:5; 5:17
 - ...if you must, you may do a gift exchange – Is 61:3
- Every time we say "Yes, Lord" the Word of the Lord is born in us... - Matt 1:24; Lk 1:38
 - ...whatever is "born of God" overcomes the world – 1 Jo 5:4

We May Then Freely Give What We Have Freely Received – Matt 10:18

- Christmas is about a willingness to give, not just to get – Acts 20:35
 - ...we are God's offerings/gifts to the world – Ja 1:18; Jo 20:21
- He lives in us to make intercession for others – Heb 7:25
 - ...intercessors address needs – Eph 4:29
