Session #3: Truth or Tradition (The New Covenant – Part 1)

Many of Us Grow Up Trying to Live New Covenant Realities by Old Covenant Theologies!

A Proper Grasp of the New Covenant Is Essential for New Covenant Living

- Not everything that's "Biblical" is "Christian" Heb 7:11,19; 8:13; 10:1
- It is the cure/antidote for both legalism and license Col 1:27
- It accurately defines and fully interprets our new creation selves II Cor 5:17; Col 3:4
- It allows us to properly confess, "Not I, but Christ" Ga 2:20; Col 2:6
- It keeps us from begging God for what we already have Il Pet 1:3,4; Eph 1:3

Stunning Truth #1: Our God Is a Covenant-Making God — Jer 31:33; Heb 8:10; Ps 25:14 (He is God "FOR" us!)

- We Deal with a God Who Initiates Relationship with Himself
 - ...an everlasting God with an everlasting desire for an everlasting family Eph 4:1-12
 - ...His covenant promise is to deliver a Person to accomplish that Gen 3:15; Gen 12; Jo 3:16
 - ...in Him there is Divine initiative and Divine continuance Ps 138:8; Phil 1:6; Il Tim 2:13
 - ...every covenant arrangement with God is always by grace through faith Eph 2:8-9
- The Ground of God's Covenant Is Always Himself, His Loving Nature Jer 31:3; Jo 3:16; Ro 5:8-10; I Jo 4:8
 - ...His holy passion for oneness 1 Jo 3:1; 1 Cor 6:17
 - ...What began in His heart He will finish in us Ps 138:8; Phil 1:6
 - ...He is both Promiser and Performer 1 Cor 1:30; Ro 4:21; Ga 3:5; Phil 2:13; Heb 13:21
- The Aim and Goal of Covenant: Two Parties Coming Together to Function As One Amos 3:3; Jo 17:22-23
 - ...rooted and grounded in knowing one another Heb 8:11; Jo 17:3
 - ...sharing life together 1 John 1
