Consider Jesus: Living By Faith Hebrews 11:1-40

Who or What Will You Authorize to Tell You What Is <u>Ultimately Real?</u>

What Faith Is:

- Personal conviction and assurance of what is trustworthy Heb 11:1
 - ...Christian faith doesn't rest upon unproven facts but upon the <u>Unseen God</u> fully revealed by <u>Jesus</u> Heb 1:2; 11:6
 - ...Christian faith in Jesus Christ ties us to <u>unseen reality</u> and empowers us to <u>live</u> accordingly Heb 11:1-2
- Faith transfers the source of my life from myself to God Heb 11:3,6
 - ...lt opens the door to genuine understanding Heb 11:3
 - ...lt is comprised of <u>Divine initiative</u> and <u>human response</u> Ro 10:17
- The reward of faith is the self-disclosure of God Heb 11:6

What Faith Does:

- It chooses to say what God Says Heb 11:7,8,24-25,31
 - ...not what personal experience or public opinion or human performance says Heb 11:11-12
- It chooses to live by the unseen Heb 11:1,27
 - ...not what is confined to sight or limited to results Heb 11:13,39
- It chooses to pay the price for believing God Heb 11:4,8-9,23,27
 - ...not what is comfortable or convenient Heb 11:25-26,35-38
- It chooses to simply obey Heb 11:8
 - ...not demand <u>explanation</u> Heb 11:3,29,30,33-34

Consider Jesus... who <u>said</u> what God said... <u>lived</u> by unseen realities... <u>paid</u> the ultimate price... <u>obeyed</u> all the way to death on the cross

- He is our means to faithfulness! - Heb 12:2
