The Christmas Story Calls for Believers and Receivers – Jo 1:12; 17:8

- God coming in Person to bring us into His family – Phil 2:6-8; 1 Jo 3:1; 4:2

...He has come for us – Lk 2:10-11

- Christmas teaches us to become receivers – Jo 1:9-14

...This is how grace works – Eph 2:5,8-9

- The promised effects: Is 9:2-6

...A great reversal: from darkness to light – Is 9:2

...A great rejoicing: the gladness of a victory won – Is 9:3

...A great rescue/release: from bondage to freedom – Is 9:4-5
