## The Crossified Life: The Way of the Cross (Mark 12:24; 1 Corinthians 1:18,24)

The Work of the Cross Is "For" Us and "In" Us – the Way of the Cross Is "Through" Us – Il Cor 4:7-12

The Way of the Cross Is the Way of Community - Ro 12:4-5; I Cor 12:12-14

- Salvation may be <u>personal</u>, but never <u>private</u> – 1 Cor 12:13,18,20

...it is a shared way - 1 Cor 12:7,8,26

...it is an irreducibly relational way - Eph 4:1-16

...it is the way of practicing the presence of people – 11 Cor 12:19; 13:10

...it is the way of our witness to the world – Jo 13:34-35

The Way of the Cross Is the Way of Intercession – Ro 8:27,34; Heb 7:25

- We identify with God's interests in others - Jo 10:11,15,17-18

(human beings are God's primary sacramental matter in the universe – Jo 17:18; 20:21)

...the way of voluntary <u>humility</u> – Phil 2:3,8 – no demand for life on our terms!

...the way of voluntary identification – Phil 2:7; Mk 1:41 – we move toward the need!

...the way of voluntary death - Phil 2:9; Matt 16:24-25 - so His Life may pour out of us!

- Our lives become the  $\underline{roads}$  that God travels - 11 Cor 4:10-12

The Way of the Cross Is the Way of Exaltation – Phil 2:9-11

- We receive the witness of <u>joy</u> Phil 2:17; Jo 16:22
  - ...a holy gladness rooted in the <u>unseen</u> things of God Heb 12:2
- We receive the witness of perspective Il Cor 4:16-18
  - ...revelation is for <u>lovers</u> Jo 14:21
- We receive the witness of authority Jo 10:18
  - ...a life that cannot be used by <u>evil</u> Jo 14:30; 1 Jo 5:18
