

“He Who Is Able”
(Ephesians 3:14-21)

“The Mystery” – the Sacred secret of Life in Christ that must be revealed by God to man, and, received by man from God only by grace through faith – Eph 2:8,9; 3:3,4,9; Col 1:27

...God alone is able to reveal the mystery and make it real in our lives – Eph 3:20

God Is Able To Strengthen Us With His Holy Spirit – Eph 3:16

- Divine purposes require Divine power – Zech 4:6; Acts 1:8

...the enabling and the ruling power of God – Eph 1:19; 3:16

...make room for the Holy Spirit to “rule”, and He will make room for the “enabling” power of Christ

- Our escort into His power: our own weakness(es) – II Cor 12:9

...with His strength there is no fear of defeat – Is 54:17; Zeph 3:17; Eph 6:10-17

God Is Able To Settle Us Down (Make Us At Home) In His Perfect Love – Eph 3:17-19

- The love that God shares with God, He shares with us – Jo 14:17,23; 17:23

...we do not focus on our love for God, but on His Love for us – Rev 2:4; I Jo 4:19; Ro 8:35-39

...His Love is a love without boundaries – I Jo 4:8

- Our escort into His Love: our own fears – Ps 56:3-4; II Tim 1:7

...His love casts out the fear that keeps us wrapped up in ourselves – I Jo 4:18

God Is Able To Fill And Flood Us With The Very Fullness Of Himself – Eph 3:19

- We were made by God to be “filled up” (“vessels”, “temples”, “branches”) – Ps 107:9; Eph 1:23; 5:18

...to be filled up with the Eternal (One) – Ecc 3:11

...an “Anti-Entropic” Life Source – Jo 1:16; Col 2:9-10; II Pet 1:3,4

(all else is entropic... “passing away” – I Jo 2:17)

- Our “escort” into His fullness: our own sense of inadequacy – II Cor 3:4-6

...He as our “Source” replaces our deficit(s) – Phil 4:13,19; Ga 2:20
